Phillipe Cunningham is the 4<sup>th</sup> Ward City Council Member representing Minneapolis' most diverse community, North Minneapolis. He is the first transgender man of color ever elected to office in the United States. Prior to being elected as a Council Member, Phillipe was Mayor Betsy Hodges' policy aide on education, youth success, racial equity, and LGBTQ rights, a special education teacher in Chicago Public Schools, and a youth worker. His top goal as the 4<sup>th</sup> Ward Council Member is to build community wealth and true affordable housing so North Minneapolis can thrive.
